THE YEAR THAT WAS

This year marked our 27th year of service to the poor, needy and the helpless in the society. This year saw us being recognized in the State as LLC (Local Level Committee) with Devashrayam becoming the LLC for the 2nd year in a row. A local level committee is instituted by the National Trust for the welfare of persons With Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Intellectual disability and Multiple Disabilities. The activities conducted as LLC are given as Annexure 1.

This year Cochin Shipyard Ltd came forward to help us accomplish a long standing wish to renovate the 1st floor of our main building. Their contribution of Rs 30 lacs ensured that we had an RC tiled roofing, along with new flooring, better electrical fixtures and new bathrooms in the building. The recommendation came through the venerable monks of Ramakrishna Mission who know of our commitment towards our projects.

We inaugurated the Mushroom Production Unit sponsored by the Lions Club of Poly Jn. The Lions club has built an entire floor in our Silver Jubilee Hall for this purpose. A staff was appointed and the unit started functioning in October 2022 after the inaugural Ceremony attended by many dignitaries from the Club as well as invited guests. Dist. Governor Lion L.N George Morely inaugurated the building.

We are extremely grateful for the whole hearted support and over-whelming participation of so many people in our activities. It gives us motivation to continue fulfilling our mission.

Ongoing projects of Devashrayam.

The projects undertaken by Devashrayam were the same as last year and can be classified under 4 sections:

- **Annadhanam** - **Providing free mid-day meal to the poor patients at Govt. District Hospital, Palakkad**
- **Ashrayam** - **Vocational rehabilitation of special needs students**

- **Ayurbandhu** - **Financial Aid for dialysis to poor patients with renal failure**
- **Free Medical Aid** - **Medicine and financial assistance to poor patients.**

ANNADHANAM

Devashrayam was established with the intent of providing a free mid-day meal to the poor patients at Govt. District Hospital, Palakkad. This was the **1st project** of our Society and very soon support from several well-wishers started pouring in. What started as a small beginning (i.e. meals to 100 patients a day in the 1st year) has assumed fairly large proportions and now more than **350 patients** receive their mid-day meal through us. This service continues uninterruptedly on all the 365 days for the past 27 years and approximately **100,000 patients** benefit every year. This number is increasing every year. Despite the soaring prices of essential commodities, the residents in and around Palakkad town contribute around 2400 kgs of rice needed for this project. Our members go on a rice collection drive every 3rd Saturday of the month and we are grateful for the generosity of the donors, in particular, Lions Club Chandranagar (50 kgs), Dhoni Church (40 kg), a well-wisher from Chandranagar colony (40 kg), CA Suresh Babu (75 kg). Our team goes to ITI Colony, Kadamkode, Akshara nagar, Kunnathurmedu, Shanti colony, Bhadradeepam apartments, Anjali Gardens, Ayodhya Nagar, Mercy college, Puthur, Chandranagar colony, Valiapadam, Sekharipuram, Victoria college. We thank all the donors & well-wishers who have donated in cash and kind to make this project run without interruption. The total cost incurred towards this project was **Rs.11,99,335.06/-**

ASHRAYAM

Devashrayam provides a safe refuge and a healthy learning environment to the mentally challenged who otherwise have now here to turn to. The vocational rehabilitation Centre was started under the guidance of Dr.T.Murali "The Rehabilitation Man of India", a person who has dedicated his life for the upliftment of the mentally ill and the retarded.

In 2022-23, 50 developmentally challenged students attended the rehabilitation center. They participate in regular morning exercises, classroom sessions, art, craft and music lessons designed as per their capabilities. Apart from that, a few of them are involved in our ongoing projects of making phenyl, liquid soap, agarbathi, candles and paper bags.

Our Khadi Unit set up by the Khadi Village Industries Board in 2002 functions very efficiently under the supervision of our trained staff Mrs. Sheena. They do a good job of spinning khadi threads and earning salaries through the Khadi board.

The sale of phenyl, liquid soap, Agarbathi and other items produced by students fetched a good income, just as in the previous years. These are the sales figures: Phenyl 480 Nos, Liquid soap 600 nos, Agarbathi 408 Nos, Handwash soap 30 nos. Earnings Rs 55,720/-

We supply liquid soap in bulk quantities to the following organisations: Instrumentation Ltd, Govt Dist Hospital Palakkad, Khadi Board Akathethara, Khadi Board Thrissur, IT Dept Palakkad, LIC Branch 1, Twon Square Club, ITI Employees co-operative society, PHC Melamuri, Krishna Coffee, BPL, Akshara school Chandranagar, Saphala Clinic Kallepully, Nila Nagar, Darshana Apartments.

Total rehabilitation expenses for the year were **Rs.4,81,044/-**

AYURBHANDHU

Our tie up with Paalana Hospital, Palakkad completed another successful year for dialysis. Poor patients with kidney malfunction/failure can carry on with their lives with the free dialyses support from this project. In addition, we have been sponsoring medicines up to 1000/- per month for around 40 patients with kidney malfunction for the last few years. We also support patients for peritoneal dialysis at the District Hospital. Our expenses towards dialysis and medicines were to the tune of **Rs.2,98,411/-** this year.

AROGYA NIDHI

This is another significant project of Devashrayam. This project operates through Friends Medicals, an authorized medical shop in Palakkad. Around **60 poor patients** are given medicines free of cost on a monthly basis on producing prescription from doctors. This year the quantum of medical aid was **Rs.7,79,877/-**. We are humbled to be of service to the ill and suffering multitudes. Much more needs to be done, however, as the number of people who need financial help are many and we are not able to meet the entire requirement. Medical insurance to the tune of Rupees Two lakh was provided to all the staff, by paying an insurance premium of **Rs.74,572/-**. We also provide education support of Rs 1500/- for school going children in the family of our staff members.

DEVASHRAYAM CHARITABLE SOCIETY AS NGO MEMBER (Registered with National Trust Act)

A local level committee u/s 13 of the National Trust for the welfare of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Intellectual disability and Multiple Disabilities Act 1999. Devashrayam Rehabilitation Centre is an NGO Member since October 2019 in the State of Kerala.

About Legal Guardianship and Niramaya Health Insurance:

- * LLC conducted legal guardianship hearing and property hearing for every month from April '22- March '23.
- * Niramaya Health Insurance Scheme is for Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities. From 2019 onwards till March 2023, 2239 health insurance cards were generated In Palakkad under Devashrayam Charitable society, as registered organization.
- * Under Section 14 of the National Trust Act, the Local Level Committee headed by the District Collector is empowered to appoint guardians for persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities. It also Provides mechanism for monitoring and protecting their interests including their properties. Eight Hundred legal guardianship certificates were granted to the persons under the National Trust Act 1999 through the Local Level Committee, Palakkad
- * Twenty house visit and property visits were conducted by LLC for protecting the rights and welfare of the beneficiaries.

Awareness Class:

- On Autism awareness Day an awareness class was conducted on April 2nd 2022 regarding legal guardianship and Niramaya health insurance policies for differently abled people, organized by the Department of Koumarabhritya, Santhigiri Ayurveda Medical college, Palakkad.
- A help desk was provided for Niramaya health insurance in the Social Justice department stall in connection with 'Ente Keralam', exhibition and trade fair conducted by Information and Public Relations Department, Palakkad Dist. This was a one week program.
- A help desk was organized regarding Niramaya health insurance and Legal guardianship at Lead college, Malampuzha in connection with World Disability Day celebration 'Unarvu 2022' on Dec 2nd.

Orientation Program:

- LLC Palakkad in association with the Department of Social Justice arranged a Zonal level, North Kerala orientation program on January 5th for National Trust Act - RPWD Registered Organizations, at Collectorate conference Hall, Palakkad.
