### THE YEAR THAT WAS

This year marked our 29<sup>th</sup> year of service to the poor, needy and the helpless in the society. Devashrayam continued as LLC for the 4th year in a row. A local level committee (LLC) is instituted by the National Trust for the welfare of persons With Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Intellectual disability and Multiple Disabilities. The activities conducted as LLC are given as Annexure 1.

We are delighted to share that Devashrayam received an award as a 'Social impact organization' for 2025, from the National Institute of Personnel Management (NIPM), Palakkad Chapter. The award was received by President Manoj CS on 22 Feb '25 at a function held in LEAD College, Dhoni. The award was presented by High court Judge Justice Deven Ramachandran in the presence of many eminent persons from Palakkad.

This year, Devashrayam founder Mrs. Beena Govind received the Children's Reunited Foundation Karmasreshta Award for her social service in the field of intellectually challenged people

After a long gap we conducted an Exhibition cum fair at Devashrayam. We wanted to showcase the culinary and craft skills of our students, their parents and our well-wishers. The event was inaugurated by Mrs Sharada, retired Head Mistress, Govt Moyan's Girls School Palakkad on Jan 10, 2025. It was a great success with around 25 stalls of food items and crafts. Most of the stalls were able to sell their products. There was camaraderie, good spirit and a sense of fulfillment among parents, teachers and students.

Our Onam celebration was also special this year as we had many guests attending the celebration. Kalabhavan Navas was the Chief Guest. In addition to, Palakkad ADM Mr. Manikandan, Dist Social Justice Officer Mr. Samir Machingal, Sub Inspector Sudheer V, Khadi Project officer Mrs. Krishna, , Dr. Santhosh Geever were present. From our Centre, President Mr. C S Manoj, Secretary Mr. M N Govind and Founder Mrs. Beena Govind participated in the programme along with all the teachers, staff and students. We had a grand cultural programme which was followed by onasadhyam for all.

We are extremely grateful for the whole hearted support and over-whelming participation of so many well-wishers in our activities. It gives us motivation to continue fulfilling our mission.

### Ongoing projects of Devashrayam.

The projects undertaken by Devashrayam were the same as last year and can be classified under 4 sections:

- **Annadhanam** - **Providing free mid-day meal to the poor patients at Govt. District Hospital, Palakkad**
- **Ashrayam** - **Vocational rehabilitation of special needs students**
- **Ayurbanthu** - **Financial Aid for dialysis to poor patients with renal failure**
- **Free Medical Aid** - **Medicine and financial assistance to poor patients.**

### **ANNADHANAM**

Devashrayam was established with the intent of providing a free mid-day meal to the poor patients at Govt. District Hospital, Palakkad. This was the **1<sup>st</sup> project** of ours Society and very soon support from several well-wishers started pouring in. What started as a small beginning (i.e. meals to 100 patients a day in the 1<sup>st</sup> year) has assumed fairly large proportions, and now more than **350 patients** receive their mid-day meal through us. This service continues uninterruptedly on all the 365 days for the past 29 years and approximately **100,000 patients** benefit every year. Despite the soaring prices of essential commodities, the residents in and around Palakkad town contribute around 2400 kgs of rice needed for this project. Our members go on a rice collection drive every 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month and we are grateful for the generosity of the donors, in particular, Lions Club Chandranagar (50 kgs), Dhoni Church (40 kgs), a well-wisher from Chandranagar colony (40 kgs), CA Suresh Babu (75 kgs), S.K Stores (10kgs), Vijayapuram Colony (10kgs), Bhadradeepam Apartment (25kgs). Our team goes to ITI Colony, Kadamkode, Akshara nagar, Kunnathurmedu, Shanti colony, Bhadradeepam apartments, Anjali Gardens, Ayodhya Nagar, Mercy college, Puthur, Chandranagar colony, Valiapadam, Sekharipuram, Victoria college. We thank all the donors &well-wishers who have donated in cash and kind to make this project run without interruption. The total cost incurred towards this project was **Rs.17,22,905/-**

### **ASHRAYAM**

Devashrayam provides a safe refuge and a healthy learning environment to the mentally challenged who otherwise have nowhere to turn to. The vocational rehabilitation Centre was started under the guidance of Dr.T. Murali "The Rehabilitation Man of India, a person who has dedicated his life for the upliftment of the mentally ill and the retarded.

In 2024-25, 54 developmentally challenged students attended the rehabilitation center. They participate in regular morning exercises, classroom sessions, art, crafts and music lessons designed as per their capabilities. Apart from that, a few of them are involved in our ongoing projects of making phenyl, liquid soap, agarbathi and candles.

Our Khadi Unit set up by the Khadi Village Industries Board in 2002 functions very efficiently year upon year. The students do a satisfactory job of spinning khadi threads and earning an income through the Khadi board.

The sale of phenyl, liquid soap, agarbathi and other items produced by students fetched a good income, just as in the previous years. These are the sales figures: Phenyl 5588 nos, Liquid soap 9536 nos, Agarbathi 529 nos, Handwash soap 203 nos and Files 157 nos. Earnings **Rs. 5,63,715/-**

We supply liquid soap in bulk quantities to the following organisations: Instrumentation Ltd, Govt Dist Hospital Palakkad, Khadi Board Akathethara, Khadi Board Thrissur, IT Dept Palakkad, LIC Branch 1, Town Square Club, ITI Employees co-operative society, PHC Melamuri, Krishna Coffee, BPL, Akshara school Chandranagar, Saphala Clinic Kallepully, Nila Nagar, Darshana Apartments.

Total rehabilitation expenses for the year were **Rs.16,25,795/-**

\*Provided financial help to the parents of the differently abled students of Devashrayam on monthly basis.

\*One time financial help (Rs.10,000/-) given to a parent (cancer patient) of an intellectually challenged ward.

\*One time financial help (Rs.10,000/-) given to Mrs Rajitha, who is looking after two intellectually challenged wards. In addition, 5 kg rice is given to some of our BPL students on monthly basis. Bed, cot and chairs were given to needy persons.

### **AYURBHANDHU**

Our tie up with Paalana Hospital, Palakkad completed another successful year for this project. Poor patients with kidney malfunction or failure can carry on with their lives with the free dialysis support from this project. In addition, we have been sponsoring medicines comes under this project up to 1000/- per month for around 40 patients with kidney malfunction for the past 18 years. Our expenses towards dialysis and medicines were to the tune of **Rs.3,00,300/-** this year.

### **AROGYA NIDHI**

This is another significant project of Devashrayam. This project operates through Friends Medicals, an authorized medical shop in Palakkad. Around **43 poor patients** are given medicines free of cost on a monthly basis, on production of a doctor's prescription. This year the quantum of medical aid was **Rs.6,63,687/-**. We are humbled to be of service to the ill and suffering multitudes. Much more needs to be done, however, as the number of people who need financial help are many and we could not meet the entire requirement.

We provide education support of Rs 1500/- per annum for school going children in the families of our staff members.

A local level committee u/s 13 of the National Trust for the welfare of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Intellectual disability and Multiple Disabilities Act 1999. Devashrayam Rehabilitation Centre is an NGO Member since October 2019 in Palakkad ,Kerala state.

#### **About Legal Guardianship and Niramaya Health Insurance:**

- \* LLC conducted legal guardianship hearing and property hearing for every month from April 24-March '25.
- \* Niramaya Health Insurance Scheme is for Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities. Nearly 2400 health insurance cards were generated In Palakkad under Devashrayam Charitable society, as registered organization.
- \* Under Section 14 of the National Trust Act, the Local Level Committee headed by the District Collector is empowered to appoint guardians for persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities. It also provides mechanism for monitoring and protecting their interests including their properties. One hundred seventy seven (177) approved legal guardianship certificates and twenty six (26) No Objection certificatess (NOC) for property case were granted to persons under the National Trust Act 1999 through the Local Level Committee, Palakkad in the year 24-25
- \* Sixteen house visits and property visits were conducted by LLC for protecting the rights and welfare of the beneficiaries.

**1.** A case, which had been pending for the last four years before the Palakkad Family Court, was resolved by the LLC in the Palakkad Local Level Committee meeting in the presence of both parties concerned. On 20 Oct 20203 the gold ornaments and money given by the bride's family at the time of marriage were returned and the case was in the Palakkad Family Court as per mutual consent. Subsequently, on 30-10-2023, the verdict in the case was delivered and the divorce was granted. LLC Convener MN Govind, Legal Member Advocate Reena ADM Sri Manikandan and other LLC Committee members attended this meeting.

**2.** Local level committee NGO member Devashrayam Charitable society has taken the responsibility of a 70 years old man (Premkumar) as legal guardian. He is suffering from diabetics, blood pressure and other old age diseases. Regular visits to his house and support with hospital services as well as essential daily items and groceries is being done.

**3.** Local Level Committee NGO member Devashrayam Charitable society provided essential daily items and groceries to an 11-year-old child with cerebral palsy, who is currently homeless. Necessary support to expedite the application process for housing under the Panchayat has been given.
